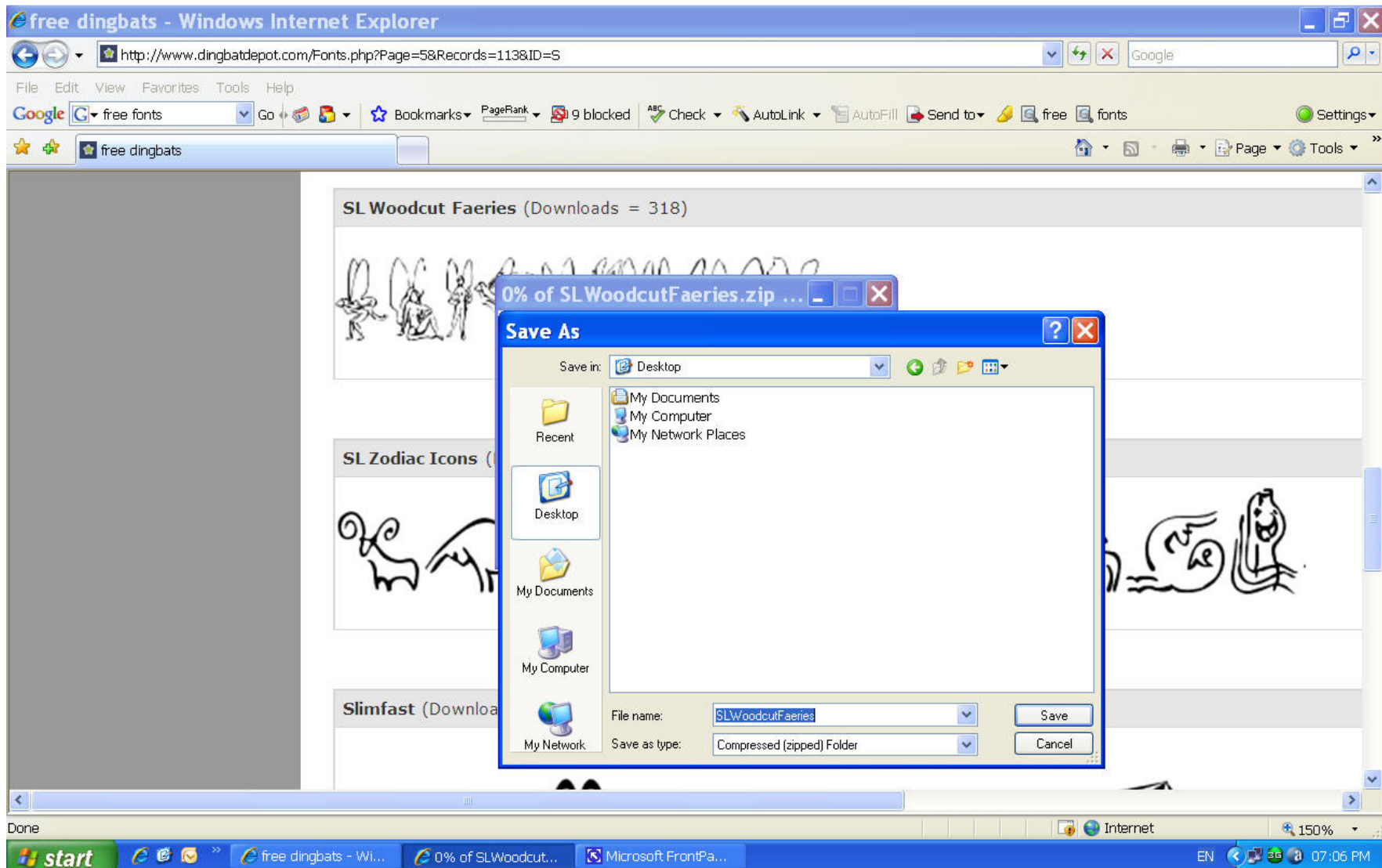
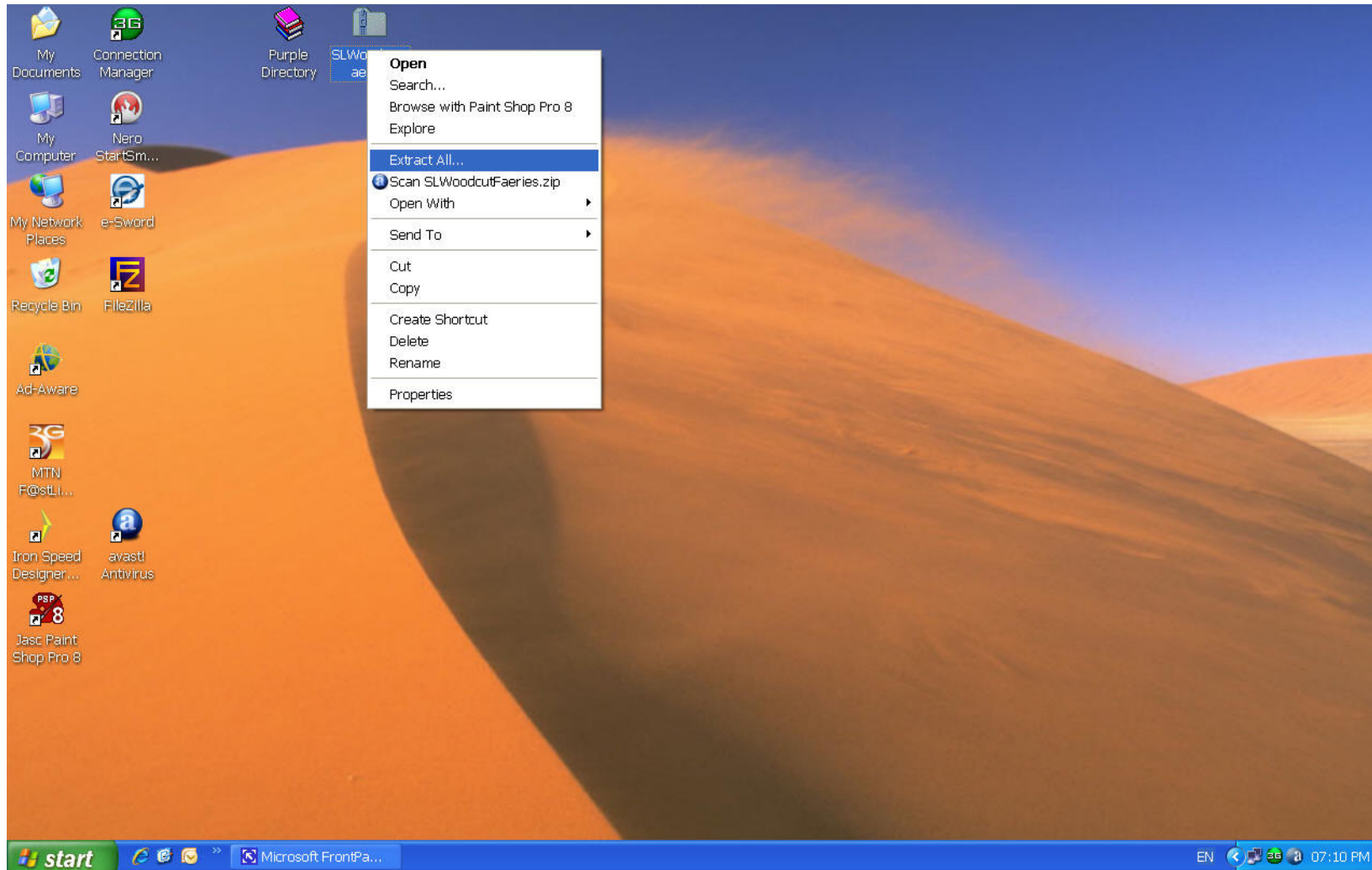


Click on the font that you like. You're then asked whether you want to open or save – rather save the zip file.
I like to save mine to my desktop (it's easier to find 😊 and then I also just back my entire Fonts folder to my external drive.)

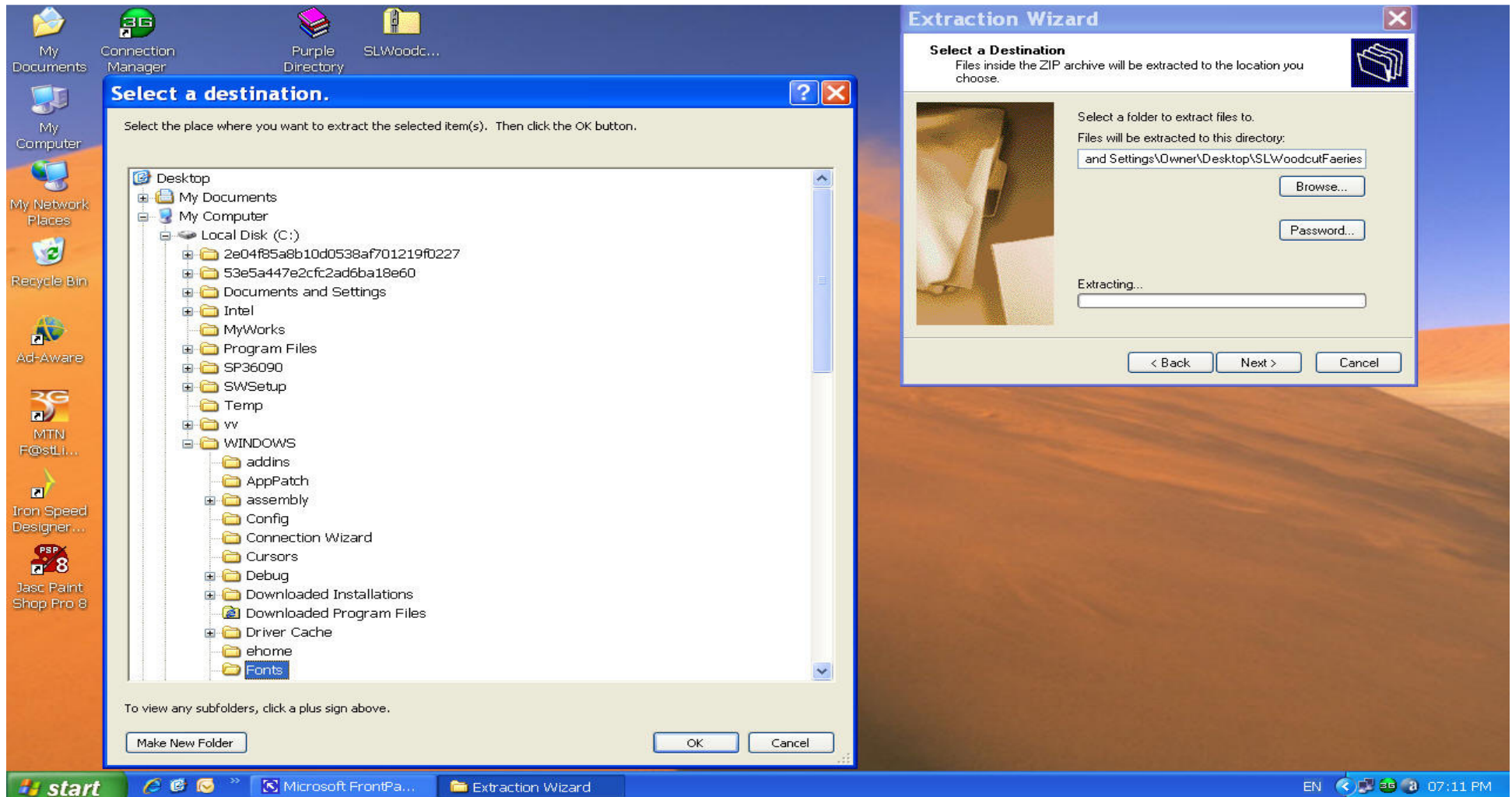


With your mouse, you then right click on the zipped icon on your desktop and select Extract All.



In the **Extraction Wizard box** (on the right of the “screen”) click on **Browse**. You then get the Select a destination box. The font folder is located on your **Local Disk (C:)**. Double click the **Windows** folder, click once on the **Fonts** folder and then click on **OK**.

You will now be back at the **Extraction Wizard box**. Click **Next** and then **Finish**. You can now select the Font in any program that you have loaded on your computer – Word, Excel, Access, Front Page, PaintShop – You can now select, colour and size the font according to your requirements.
